



100 BELLS OF PEACE CEREMONY

100 BELLS OF PEACE

The Men's Club of Selby and Empey Hill will be organizing an initiative that honours the 100'th anniversary of the signing of the Armistice that ended the fighting of the First World War.

The 100 BELLS OF PEACE project was initiated by the Royal Canadian Legion in partnership with Veteran Affairs Canada.

On Nov. 11, 1918, when news of this Armistice broke, churches across Canada responded by spontaneously ringing their bells. 100 BELLS OF PEACE will honour that event all over Canada by pealing a bell 100 times at sunset on Sunday November 11, 2018.

This is not to replace the traditional 11:00 a.m. Remembrance Day ceremony. It is a recognition of the 100'th anniversary.

At 4:00 p.m., our 100 BELLS OF PEACE ceremony will be held at the Selby church. After introductions and a few words, people in attendance will be encouraged to speak about a friend or relation who participated in WW I. If you have a story to tell, or one that you want a child or grandchild to tell, please let Dave Stapley know (613-689-9060).

At 4:51 p.m., (Selby's sunset) we will invite the first 100 children or adults if required, to each ring the church bell until 100 peals have been completed at 5 second intervals.

At 5:00 p.m. the ceremony will be closed with a reading of In Flanders Field, hopefully by one of our volunteer children.

This unique event is open to the entire community and certainly as many children as possible. Invite your friends and neighbours, folks from other churches and anyone interested in celebrating this 100'th anniversary.
