## From the Selby Property and Finance Committee - Basement Floor Fund

Due to 143 years of moisture, dry-rot and sagging our basement floor is in need of replacing. This will be a major undertaking, requiring the entire floor and supports to be removed, and a new concrete floor to be poured. The estimate for this project is around \$30,000.
