His debut album "TradHead" (2019) was nominated in the Instrumental Solo Artist category at the Canadian Folk Music Awards (2020), and the first single, "Fractions" from his second album received the 2021 Songs From the Heart Instrumental Award from Folk Music Ontario. Graham's music has been played on the Carillon in the Peace Tower of Parliament Hill, in Sweden, cruising in international waters and at festivals and venues in Canada.
